A panel will discuss the design and construction of the Spirit of St. Louis airplane which Charles A. Lindbergh flew in the first solo transatlantic flight in 1927. The cirplane was built in San Diego by Ryan Airlines, Inc., to Lindbergh's specifications. Three members of the panel are men who worked on the airplane; the fourth will draw comparisons with modern cractice. Mr. Hall was the Chief Engineer, Mr. van der Liede was Flight Line Mechanic, and Mr. Rohr was proprietor of Standard Sheet Metal Works (the sheet metal sub-contractor on the Spirit of St. Louis).

The discussion will be illustrated by slides and motion pictures. There will be an exact replica of the Spirit of St. Lowis on display, together with the original engineering documents involved with the airplane design. A photograph of the cirplane will be given to each person attending the meeting.

The installation of the 1959-1960 slate of officers will be made at this meeting.
